GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING ABSTRACT

- Minimum 350 words and maximum 500 words.
- The abstract must be written in English using the single space 12 pt Times New Roman font with following details:-
 - 1.First paragraph indicating objectives and background details.
 - 2.Second paragraph materials, methods or experiment.
 - 3.Third paragraph highlighting the observations, finding, discussion and importance.

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING POSTER

- The size of poster should be 2.5 ft. X 4 ft. (width x height)
- Poster should be structured in following segments:-
 1. Introduction
 2. Experimental details, methods, materials, etc.
 3. Observations, Results and Discussion, Tables, Diagrams etc.
 4. Conclusions
 5. Acknowledgement
 6. References as per internationally accepted style.
